

Spears® Lead-Free Compliance In Plumbing Products

LF-2-1209

California's Low-Lead plumbing law (California Health & Safety Code Section 116875; commonly referred to as AB1953) and Vermont Lead in Consumer Products law (Act 193); effective January 1, 2010, prohibits the sale of any plumbing products intended to convey water for human consumption through drinking or cooking that contain lead in excess of a 0.25% weighted average. NSF International has developed a recognized evaluation protocol, NSF-61 Annex G, which serves as independent 3rd party certification of product compliance to California and Vermont low-lead plumbing laws.
