

# ACROSS THE POOL VOLLEYBALL/BADMINTON GAME ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

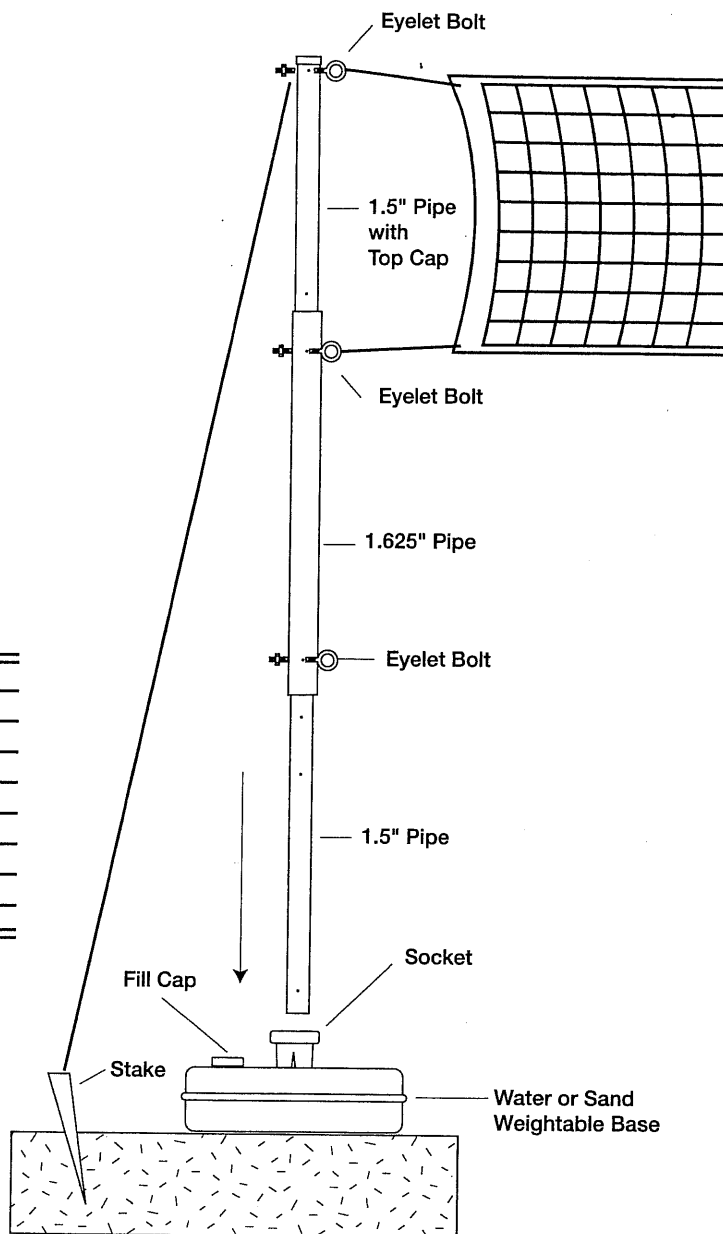
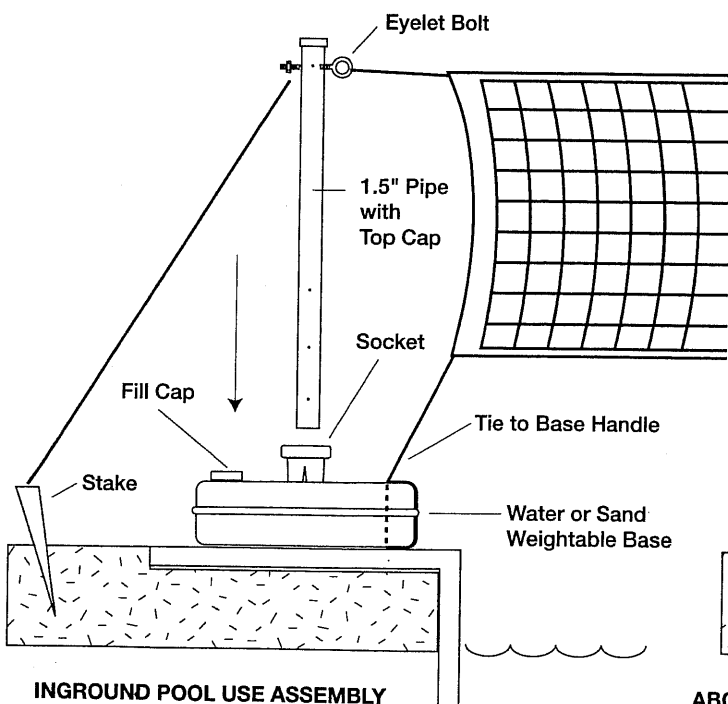

## CONTENTS:

For ease of assembly, check and organize all contents

Your game should include:

- 2 - 32" x 1.5" pre-drilled pipe with top cap
- 2 - 32" x 1.5" pre-drilled pipe
- 2 - 32" x 1.625" pre-drilled pipe
- 6 - 2.00" eyelet bolts and nuts
- 2 - Water or sand weightable bases with sockets
- 1 - Volleyball with inflate needle
- 1 - Volleyball net
- 4 - Badminton racquets with 4 birdies
- 2 - Stakes and 10' of cord



## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do the following twice for both left and right net support assemblies.
2. Fill base with water or sand and re-cover base opening with cap. Insert socket into base and twist to secure.
3. **FOR INGROUND POOL USE:** Use 32" x 1.5" Pipe with top cap. Insert pole into socket. Install 1 - 2.00" eyelet bolt and nut in top hole, the eyelet facing inward to accept net tie. Tie net to eyelet. Next, tie one end of nylon rope around handle on base and the other end to bottom of net. See illustration above for inground pool use assembly. Proceed to step 6.
4. **FOR ABOVE GROUND POOL OR ON GROUND USE:** Orient 32" x 1.5" pipe without top cap so that three pre-drilled holes are facing UP and one hole is facing DOWN. Insert pole into socket. Next slide 1.625" x 32" pipe over 1.5" pipe and secure with 1 - 2.00" eyelet bolt and nut. You may adjust for overall net height by using your choice of pre-drilled holes. Slide 32" x 1.5" pre-drilled pipe with top cap into 1.625" pipe and secure with 1 - 2.00" eyelet bolt and nut. Face eyelet inward to accept net tie.
5. Secure remaining eyelet bolt to uppermost hole at top of pole assembly. Face eyelet inward to accept net tie. Tie net to eyelets.
6. For additional stability of net supports, It is recommended to use rope and stakes supplied, as shown.
