BATTERY REQUIREMENTS & INSTALLATION:

Please follow all directions. Swamp Buggy Requires the following batteries:

- At least one 9.6-volt rechargeable nickel-cadmium (Ni-Cd) or nickel-metal hydride (Ni-MH) battery pack and battery pack charger (Swimline Item# 9126, sold separately).
- . One 9-volt battery for the transmitter.

WARNING: Dispose of batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them. **CAUTION:**

- · Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- · If you do not plan to use the Swamp Buggy for a week or more, remove the batteries from the transmitter and the Swamp Buggy. Batteries can leak chemicals that can damage electronic parts.
- Never leave dead or weak batteries in the Swamp Buggy or transmitter.
- Do not charge or recharge the battery pack while it is in the Swamp Buggy.
- After you charge or recharge the battery (4 to 4.5 hours), disconnect it from the charger. Overcharging the battery pack might damage it.
- Parents are recommended that the transformer be periodically examined for conditions that may result in the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons and that, in an event such conditions. the transformer should not be used until properly repaired.

INSTALLING BATTERIES IN THE TRANSMITTER:

- 1. Turn ON/OFF on the transmitter to OFF.
- 2. Use a Phillips screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover, then remove the cover.
- 3. Put the battery in the compartment as indicated by the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside.
- 4. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw.

When the transmitter's range decreases, replace its battery.

INSTALLING BATTERIES IN THE SWAMP BUGGY:

Before you use the 9.6-volt battery pack, you must charge it using a battery charger. Follow the charger's directions to charge the battery pack!

- 1. Turn ON/OFF on the back of the Swamp Buggy to OFF.
- 2. Turn the latches on the battery compartment cover on top of the Swamp Buggy counter-clockwise until it stops, then lift up and remove the cover.
- 3. Attach the battery pack's connector to the Swamp Buggy matching connector. Do not force them! They fit together only one way.
- 4. Carefully tuck the battery wire into the battery compartment, then replace the battery compartment cover and secure it by turning the latches clockwise until it stops.

When the Swamp Buggy moves slowly or not at all, change the 9.6V battery pack or recharge it according to the battery charger's instructions.

RADIO CONTROL DRIVING


- 1. Turn ON/OFF to ON.
- 2 Fully extend the antenna on the transmitter and turn OFF/ON on the transmitter to ON. The indicator on the transmitter lights.
- 3 Use the transmitter's control levers to move and steer the Swamp Buggy.
- 4. When the Swamp Buggy goes outside the transmitter's control range, it stops. Hold the transmitter as high as possible with the antenna vertical to try to re-establish contact. If you cannot, you must move closer to the Swamp Buggy to control it again, but be careful not to wade into deep water or strong currents.
- 5. When the batteries begin to lose power, the Swamp Buggy slows down. So you don't lose your Swamp Buggy, guide the Swamp Buggy to shore as soon as you notice it slowing down.
- 6. When you finish driving the Swamp Buggy, turn OFF/ON on the Swamp Buggy and the transmitter to OFF.

SWAMP BUGGY FUNCTION CONTROLS

Install fully charged rechargeable batteries into the Swamp Buggy battery compartment and transmitter in the correct position as indicated. Install transmitter antenna as indicated. Move power switches located on the top of the Swamp Buggy and front of the transmitter to the "on" positions. Fully extend transmitter antenna, Place Swamp Buggy on the water surface.

- To drive forward, move "Joystick A" + "Joystick B' upward.
 To drive in reverse, move "Joystick A" + "Joystick B' downward.
- To turn right, move "Joystick A" upward + "Joystick B" downward.
 To turn left, move "Joystick B" upward + "Joystick A" downward.





CAUTION:

- · Be sure the transmitter's antenna is retracted before turning it off.










SWAMP BUGGY POWER SWITCH & LATCHES
